***What is distance learning?***

Learning remotely is not the same as learning in a brick-and-mortar school setting. The operation of the live setting versus the remote setting is very different. When we are in school for 6.5+ hours a day, students have transitions. They are going to specials, they have lunch, then recess. In the classroom, the teacher provides instruction, then there are times when the students are working independently, or they are working with other students. The live environment is very collaborative.

The remote learning day is condensed. The interaction that would normally take place in the live classroom is gone and replaced with a very different form of interaction. Students access instruction online.

***What does our structure look like?***

ADV teachers will provide students lessons through a combination of live sessions and recorded sessions via Zoom, as well as assignments posted to Edmodo.

## Student Code of Conduct for Online Classes

1. Attend your classes. Check into your classes DAILY by answering your teachers' poll questions AND hitting "Like." Do this each morning by 11:00.
2. Be kind. Keep all communication courteous, appropriate, and on task. Remember that your written words don't have a voice.
3. Be respectful. Do not misrepresent yourself in your communication or in images.
4. Do not post or share inappropriate material, even if it is "private."
5. Be safe. Alert your teacher or administration should anyone you do not know try to contact you or should someone communicate to you in an inappropriate manner.

Middle school students must check into every class – all 7 periods.

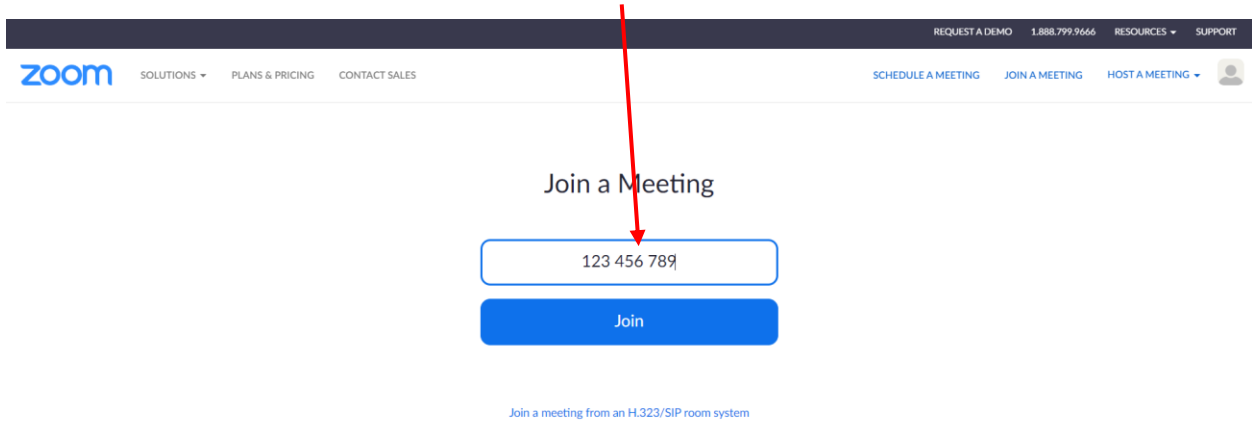
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Please check-in by 11:00 AM. After that, teachers will reach out. The goal is for students to make this their daily habit; it’s what they do first thing for school.

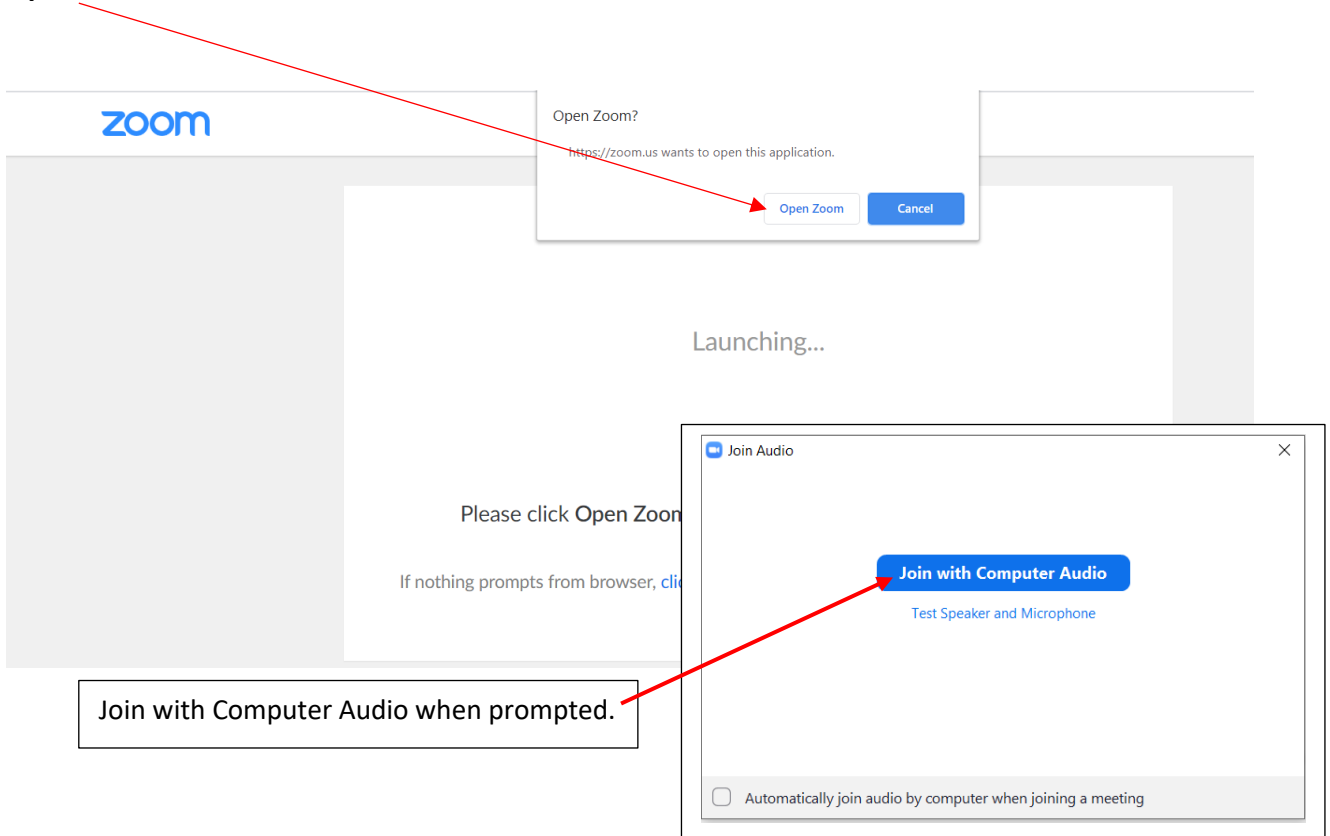
## Zoom “Live” Sessions

## Open the Zoom Call.

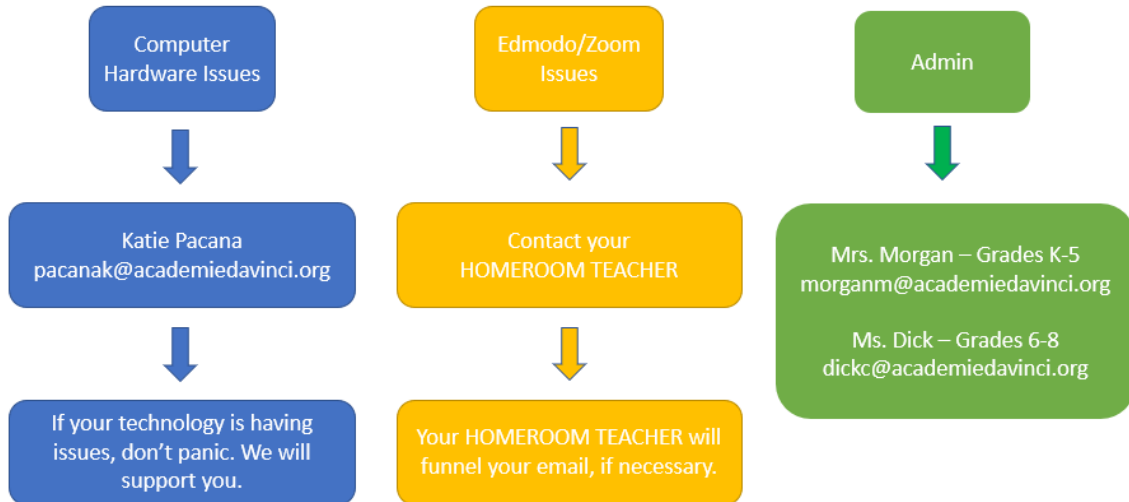
